The penitentiary Administration hosted the annual workshop of the Central Europe Penitentiary Administrations (MECR) on 18th and 19th September 2019.

MECR is an informal body, created in 2009, that gathers the Directors General (Heads of Department) of a restricted number of Central and Eastern Europe Penitentiary Administrations, extended also to Italy. The goal of the body's meetings is to create an occasion for debate, exchange of opinion and reciprocal enrichment among the Heads of the different prison systems, on various topics, such as: the problem of overcrowded institutes; the good norms for inmates' reintegration; the daily efforts for guaranteeing to inmates the respect of human rights; the positive experience with the penitentiary personnel, etc.

This event represented a prestigious and unique occasion for the diffusion at higher levels of the TRAIIn Training project development and results, considering the evaluation procedures of risk assessment that are being experimented in six Italian penal institutions.

In this framework, the description of the fight against violent radicalisation in penitentiary field was committed to the Commissioner Coordinator, Augusto Zaccariello, Commander of the NIC (national investigational committee) of Penitentiary Police, that is the major expert in terms of Italian Penitentiary Administration.
