The *TRAIIn Training* Project planning contains some aspects devoted to **Research**, mainly embodied by the academic-scientific Partners (Universities in Milan, Naples, and Padua, and Research Centers as the Siracusa Institute) as well as some activities, centered on the **practical aspects** of the penitentiary practitioners' function.

In fact, the aim of the Project may be described as follows: try to experience and test in every day's practice, and in different contexts of penal execution (prisons for adult inmates, juvenile centers, and probation settings) the instruments and methods found by the Researchers.

Of course, it would be impossible to involve the whole world of the penal execution as a target of the *TRAIIn Training* activities, and so, the experiences that were achieved have had the character of **pilot programs**. For example, the *Prison Staff Training* implemented by Partner TRANSCRIME – University of Milan – involved “only” 180 practitioners, in 12 Italian institutes.

On the other hand, it is fundamental that prevention and detection strategies towards violent radicalization are coherently implemented – if successfully tested in the pilot setting – in the whole **national** context (and possibly **trans-national** context, although adapted to the different features of the single States).

This is the reason why a **Dissemination** phase is considered necessary, in order to allow a major number of penitentiary practitioners, who didn't or could not join the pilot program, to share the results and improve their own skills and methods, towards this phenomenon, in their daily work.

FOR THESE REASONS, *TRAIIn TRAINING* HAS PRODUCED **FOUR WEBINARS**, ADDRESSED TO PENITENTIARY PRACTITIONERS IN THEIR DIFFERENT ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES, THAT WILL BE AVAILABLE ON A DEVOTED
